What is the Gospel?

The Gospel is becoming increasingly vague and morphed into something which is completely opposite from the Gospel taught in the Bible. It will do our hearts good to reflect on the grandeur of the message God has given as the remedy for our desperate situation.

<u>The Depth of the Problem – The Nature and Extent of our Sin—It's Depth</u>

Key Passages

Romans 1:18 – 32; Romans 3:9-19

The Depth of the Problem - The Nature and Extent of our Sin—Our Guilt in Adam

Key Passages

Romans 5:12ff; I Corinthians 15:22

Adam was our representative at the very beginning. His choice made us all guilty. All human beings are initially in Adam with him as their representative. Those who remain "in Adam" have his guilt imputed to them and are ultimately lost.

Christ is the representative of another group of people. Those who are "in Christ" have His righteous obedience imputed to them and are saved.

<u>The Depth of the Problem – The Greatness of the God We've Offended</u>

God is infinitely powerful, knowledgeable and wise. He is perfect in righteousness, love, justice, purity and holiness. There is no darkness, impurity or unrighteousness in Him.

Substitution – The Great Exchange

The Greatness of the Remedy – Out of Adam and Into Christ

Do a study of what you have in Christ and your identification with Him in His death and resurrection.

The Greatness of the Remedy – How it's Applied to Individuals

Repentance and Faith – Two sides of the same coin

Key Passages

Isaiah 55:7; Mark 1:15; Acts 20:21

Repentance is the giving up hope, trust and confidence in everything else while turning in faith to Christ as the only hope and remedy for our sin. God commands all men everywhere to repent. (Acts 17:30)

Additional Passages:

Acts 10:43; John 3:18; Ephesians 2:8, 9; Acts 16:31; Romans 10:9,13; 1 John 3:23; 5:13

Scriptural words: call (Romans 10:9), believe (Acts 16:31), receive (John 1:12)

The New Birth

Key Passages:

Ezekiel 36:26; Jeremiah 31:33; John 3; 1 Peter 1:23; Titus 3:5; 2 Corinthians 4:4-6; John 1:12, 13

We need to remember that salvation is of the Lord (Jonah 2:9). He draws people to himself (John 6:44), opens their eyes (2 Corinthians 4:4-6), grants repentance (Acts 11:18, 2 Timothy 2:25), opens hearts (Acts 16:14) and gives faith (Eph 2:8,9; 2 Thess 3:2).
