1. What is the God-head like as the end begins to unfold?
2. What spiritual beings are present?
3. The resurrection
 - a. When and who? Daniel 12:1-3; 1 Cor 15:23; 1 Thess 4:16
 - b. What kind of body? 1 Cor 15:35-48; Phil 3:21; Luke 24:39-42
4. The judgment seat of Christ
 - a. Who is judged there and what is outcome? 2 Cor 5:10; 1 Cor 3:15; 1 Cor 4:5; Matt 25:21,23
5. What is the relationship of the saints to God the Son? Hebrews 2:11; Eph 5:30-33; 1 Cor 6:16-17; Romans 8:17; 2 Peter 1:4; Rev 20:4
6. The judgment begins. Daniel 7:9-10; Rev 4:2-5:14
 - a. The 24 elders.
 - b. Saints will rule and reign with Christ. 1 Peter 2:9; 2 Tim 2:12; Rev 5:10; Rev 20:4-6
 - c. Saints will judge angels. 1 Cor 6:2-3
 - d. Tribulation on earth – The church not there because Church is body and bride of Christ. Eph 1:23
7. Marriage Supper of the Lamb will take place. Rev 19:6-8
8. Second coming of Christ, Matthew 24:27-31; Matt 25:31-34 (Note kingdom was prepared for them before the foundation of the earth; Rev 19:11 and following
 - a. Who will be with Him? (See also 1 Thess 3:13)
 - b. He will be glorified in His Saints on that day. 2 Thess 1:3ff, esp vs 10; 1 Thess 2:12; Eph 1:18; Col 3:4
 - c. All creation has been longing for that day. Romans 8:17-23
 - b. Enemies defeated
 - d. Satan bound
 - e. Kingdom established on earth. Isa 11; 65:17
 - f. Final judgment on Satan, Death and the Lost – Cast into the Lake of Fire Matt 25:42; Rev 20:11-15
See also 1 Cor 15:24-28, 54

9. Eternal state is ushered in

- a. Both millennial kingdom and eternal kingdom have unending praise. Rev 5:8-14; Rev 19:6
- b. New Heavens and New Earth Rev 21:1ff; 2 Peter 3:10-13
- c. New Jerusalem revealed. Rev 21:9ff; John 14
Called the bride because the bride will be the main occupant. Phil 3:20
- d. Commerce will take place. Rev 21:22-22:4
- e. All things gathered into one. Eph 1:10,
There will be one throne. Rev 22:3 (Compare with Rev 3:21)
See also 1 Cor 15:24-28

10. So what was the purpose of all of this?

- a. The creation of “one new man” in Christ to the glory of God. Ephesians 2:15
- b. To gather all things together in Christ. Eph 1:9-10
- c. To praise the glory of His grace. Eph 1:6
- d. That He might continue to show the riches of His grace through the ages. Eph 2:7
- e. That the manifold wisdom of God might be displayed by the Church. Eph 3:10-11
- f. That Christ would indwell human beings. Colossians 1:26-27
