

## Worldview Timeline Review

### Before Time Began:

1. God was present as Father, Son and Holy Spirit before anything was created.
2. There was love, fellowship and communication among the persons of the Godhead.
3. There was planning and agreement among the persons of the Godhead.
4. The entire plan and counsel of God is eternal and finalized before anything was created (see page 8 #10).
5. God's purpose and goal in creating is clearly taught throughout scripture as being for His glory and the praise of His great name.
6. God must have concluded that the plan which included the potential for sin to enter would bring more glory to Himself than a plan which didn't have that possibility. And of course the words *potential* and *possibility* really don't fit a God who "works all things after the counsel of His own will." But the point is we must not see the entrance of sin as a surprise to God or something for which He needed to find a solution. The Son has always been the "Lamb slain from the foundation of the world" (Rev 13:8).
7. The three persons of the Godhead each had a role in creation as well as in the redemption of a people who would be given to the Son as His body and bride (see page 8 #11).

### After Time Has Ended:

8. After time has ended all three members of the Godhead are still present with the Son having a wounded, glorified, human body.
9. In addition to the Trinity there exist saved and fallen angels and saved and fallen human beings.
10. The saints in their glorified human bodies have received rewards and commendation. Their relationship to the Son of God is that of bride, brothers, joint-heirs, partakers of the divine nature, of His flesh and bones, and one spirit with Him. They reign with Him and participate in judging angels and rule on the earth.
11. The saints will come with Christ and He will be glorified in His saints on that day. All creation has been longing for that day.
12. In the eternal state there will be unending praise as the manifold wisdom and grace of God are displayed for all conscious beings to observe for all eternity.
